



Rules & Regulations

Campaign

1. All young people voting must be 13-19 years old live, work or study in Ealing.
2. All Candidates to get permission from premises owners for where the location they decide to campaign their manifesto.
3. All candidates to respect other candidate's campaigns.
4. Do not give out personal contact details on any literature used in campaigning, for your own safety.
5. Beware of copyright; don't use any logos or slogans belonging to another company, including Ealing council.
6. Do not publicise a political party or association with a political party in your campaign.
7. Do not deface public property, litter or place publicity materials anywhere without appropriate permissions. Also, seek permission from the necessary authority over the locations you choose to campaign in.
8. Votes must be cast by eligible persons who are **knowingly** voting for youth mayor- details must not be collected through other means.
9. Your manifestos alone should be the reason voters choose to vote for you, please don't use other incentives. (Bribes)

Voting

1. All young people must respect the polling area
2. Young people can only vote once.
3. You must not bring your ballot papers already filled out to the polling booth.
4. Online votes need to be emailed back to ealingyouthmayor@hotmail.co.uk by 18th-28th April 2011
5. Final votes must be in by 28th April 2011 at midnight.
