



# Cash 4 youth

## What are the Youth Opportunity & Capital Funds

Ealing's "cash 4 youth" is an opportunity to get funds for **all** young people in the community. This funding is unique because it is funding decided by young people for young people. (Cash 4 youth gives grants to support young people's good ideas to benefit their communities). In a few words the:

- Youth opportunity fund is for activities, for example, it may be a training day to become a volunteer or it may be money spent on a talent show or sports project.
- Youth capital fund is for bigger, longer lasting things like building an activity playground, buying equipment or refurbishing a building.

**Don't forget that the two funds do work hand in hand.**

#### Criteria: Applications

- **Must** be made by young people aged 13 – 19 years old, but young people **can** consult and discuss their idea, project or activity with a supporting adult
- Must be for new or **additional** activities and things to do
- Must be open to young people / groups from Ealing and include different cultural, ethnic and social backgrounds
- Bids from young people from different backgrounds and areas working together to plan, put on and enjoy activities, to enable them to gain better understanding of each other will **enhance** the bid
- Should fit into one or more of the following:
  - ☺ Be Healthy
  - ☺ Stay Safe
  - ☺ Enjoying and Achieving
  - ☺ Making a Positive Contribution
  - ☺ Achieving Economic Well-Being
- Must prove that the activity is needed
- A focus on hard-to-reach young people and disadvantaged communities e.g. young disabled people and young refugees, will **enhance** the bid
- Must be cost effective
- Must explain what young people will gain

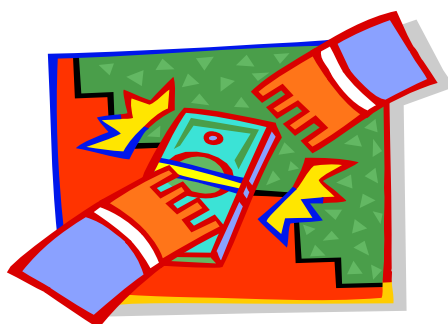
